Methodology: This grant program allocates \$3M in CARES Act funding to Fresno County cities who did not independently receive Federal allocations. The allocation is based on a weighted distribution that is 50% population-based and 50% COVID-19 case impacts based.

- 50% (\$1.5M) is distributed to each City by factoring its population as a proportion of the total population of the selected cities of the grant.

- 50% (\$1.5M) is distributed to each City by 1) calculating the number of total cases (active and closed COVID-19 cases), 2) calculating the cases per 1,000 persons for the cities and for the total of the selected cities, 3) then factoring to each city their cases/1,000 as a proportion of the total of the selected cities.
